



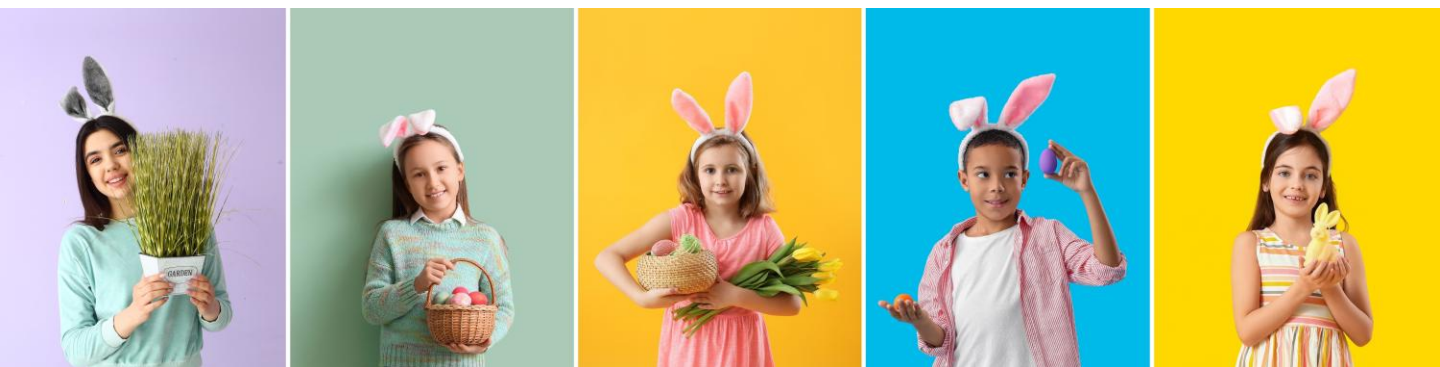

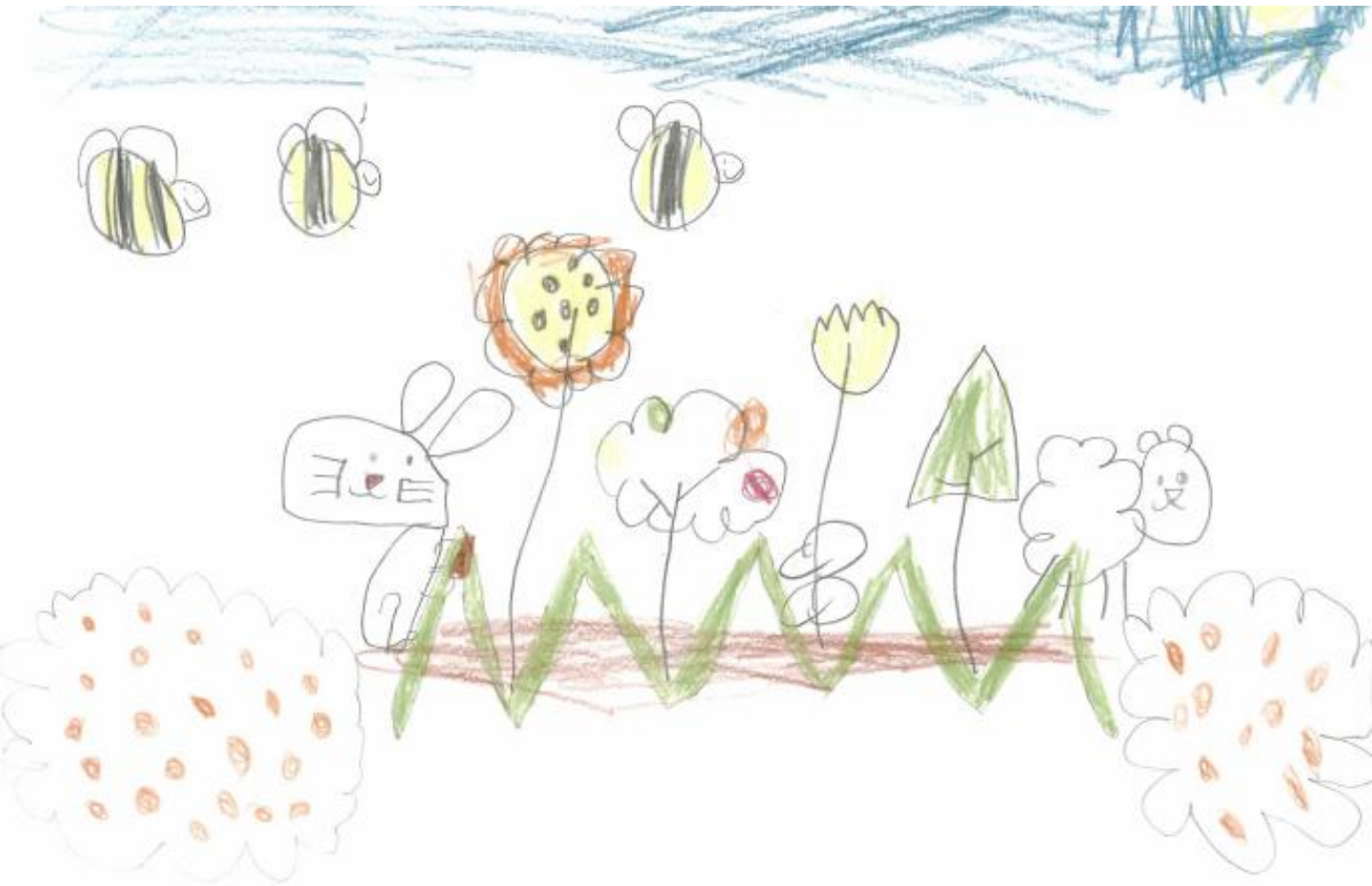

Year 1

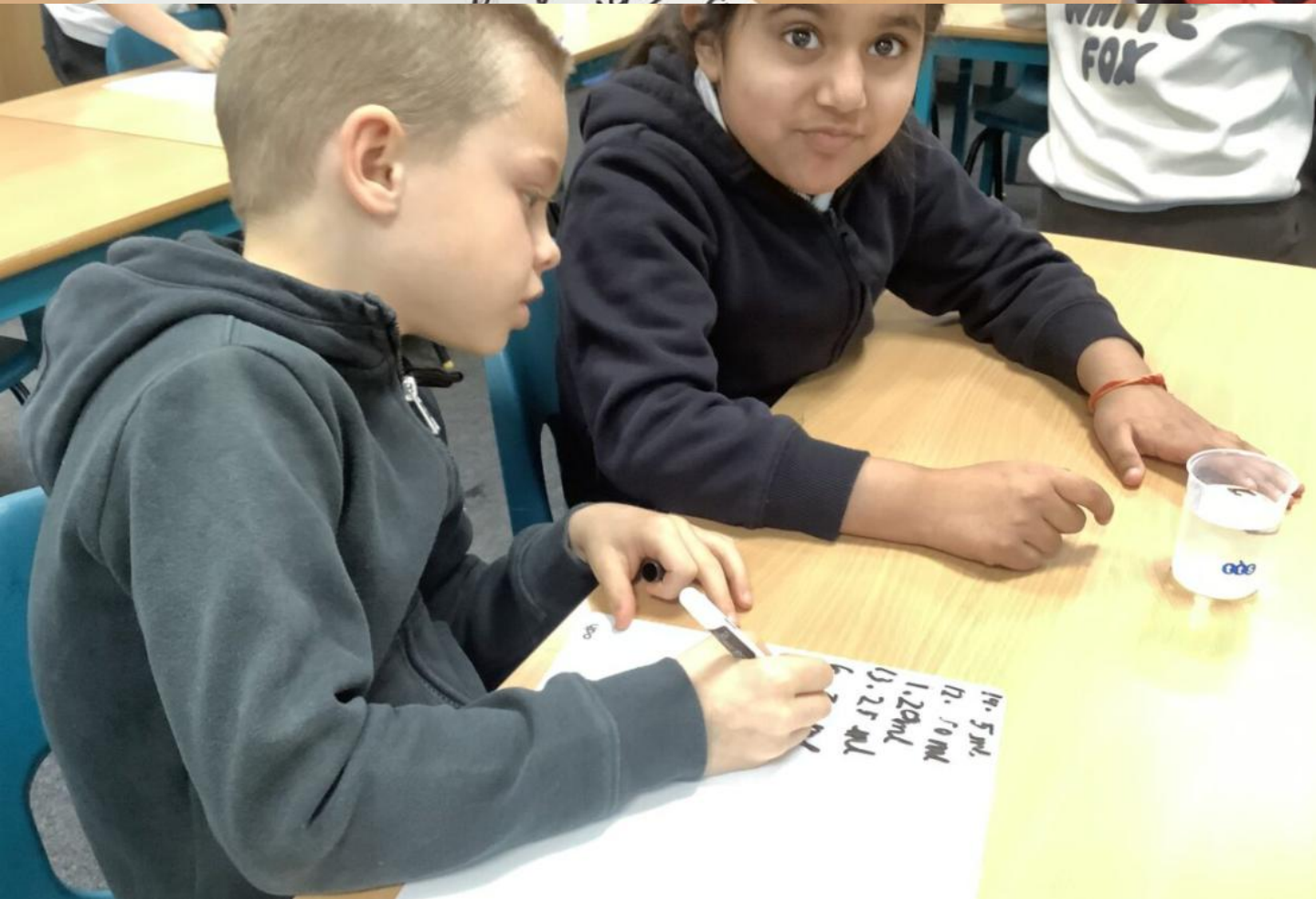
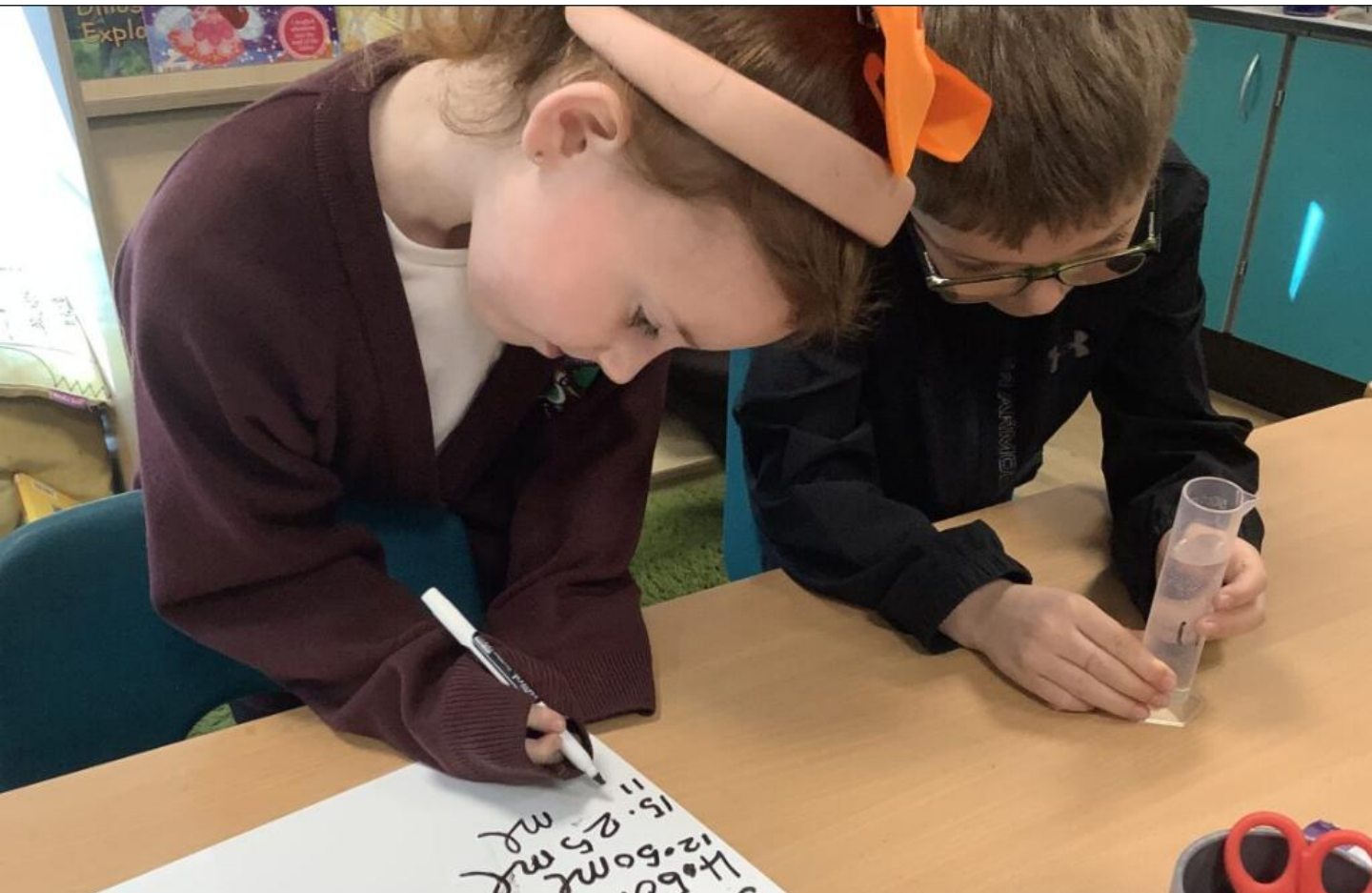

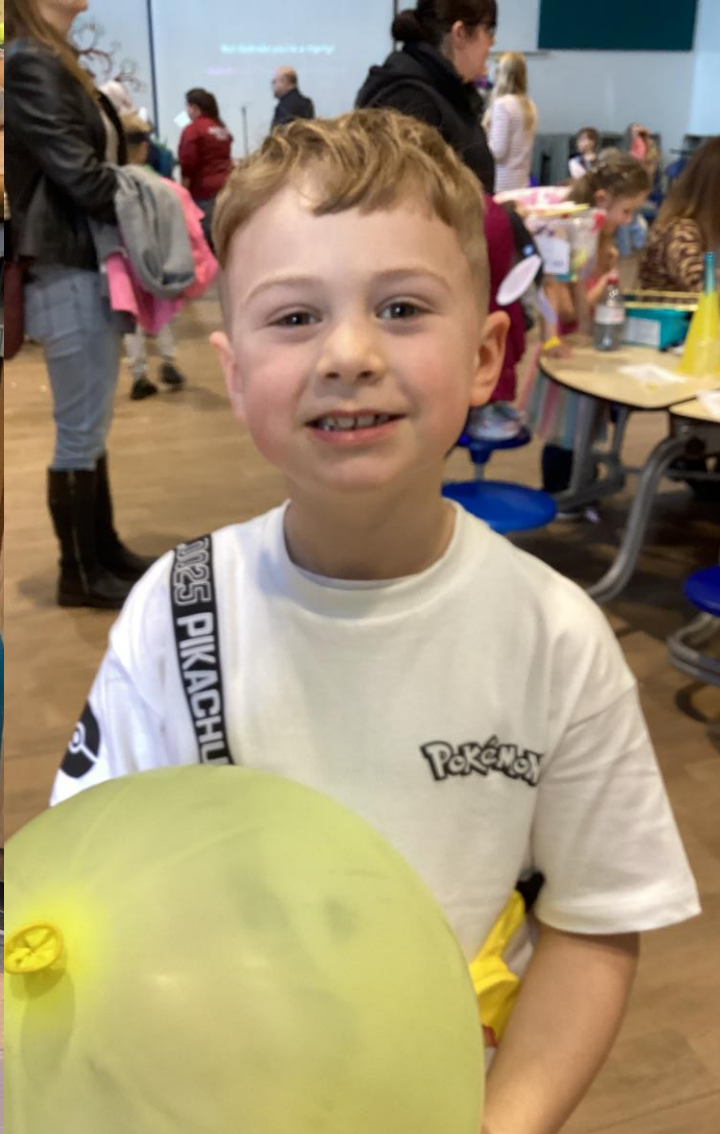




Year 2

Year 3 News

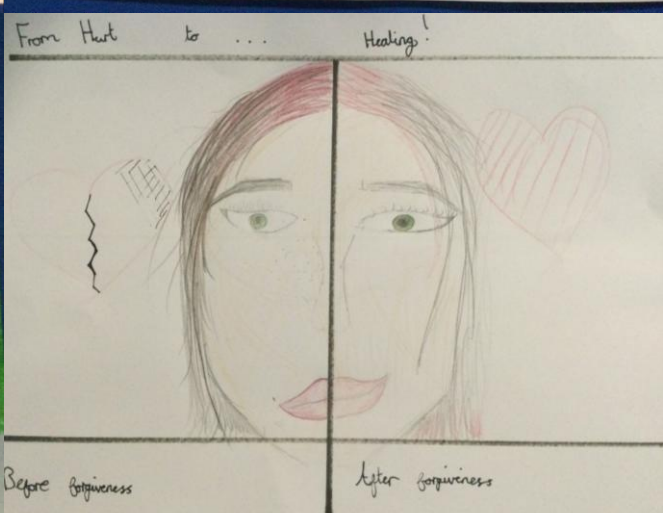

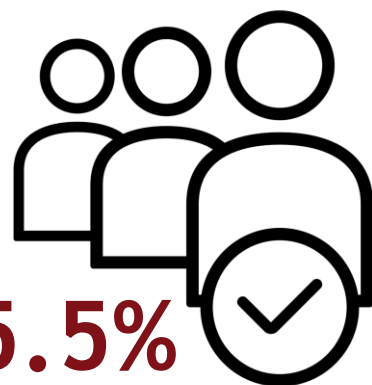
Year 6

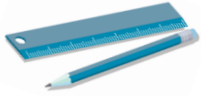
