Dear Families

As we approach the end of the school year, we would like to reiterate our expectations regarding school uniform and introduce some changes to our policy. When the children return to school in September, we expect all children to follow our uniform policy. We value who we are as a community and want to encourage our children to feel pride in our school.

School Uniform

We expect children to wear a maroon jumper or cardigan and a white shirt, with a grey skirt or pinafore dress, or grey trousers. Children should wear their tie every day. We also expect children to wear plain black shoes. Plain black, trainer-style shoes are acceptable, as long as they do not have brightly coloured or white labels, logos, soles, or markings.

White polo shirts, grey shorts, and blue checked dresses may be worn during the summer term.

P.E. Clothing

Children must come to school wearing their PE kit on the required day to take part in PE lessons. Indoor lessons may sometimes take place barefoot; however, appropriate footwear is required for outdoor lessons.

Our school PE kit consists of a plain white T-shirt, black shorts, a plain, non-branded black tracksuit for colder weather, and trainers.

Sensory Uniform Changes

We have decided to make changes to the uniform options available for children who find it difficult to wear the full school uniform. These changes have been made to align with Lord Lawson, our secondary feeder school, as we feel this will make transition easier in the long term.

Any child may choose to wear *Easy Wear* uniform. This uniform is available to purchase from all major supermarkets and uniform providers and provides accessible options, including features such as:

- Easy-fastening Velcro fastenings
- Mock button fastenings
- Sensory-kind designs with soft seams for extra comfort

Bags

Due to changes in how bags will be stored, we no longer have sufficient space to accommodate large rucksacks. From September, children will therefore be permitted to bring **bookbags only** to school. School-branded bookbags are available to purchase for £6.45 using the [link](#) provided. Alternatively, parents may choose to provide their own non-branded bookbag if preferred.

Jewellery

We discourage the wearing of jewellery in school for health and safety reasons; however, a wristwatch may be worn. If absolutely necessary, small stud earrings may be worn, but children must be able to remove them independently for PE lessons. All jewellery is brought into school entirely at the child's own risk.

Children will be required to remove any items of jewellery that contravene this code. Such items will be confiscated and returned when collected by a parent or carer.

Make-up, Hair, and Nails

Make-up of any description is not allowed. Nail varnish, gel, or acrylic nails are not permitted, and false nails must not be worn. Please do not allow children to come to school with brightly coloured hair or extreme hairstyles.

Staff will be vigilant in ensuring children are dressed smartly and in line with the school uniform policy. We also have a bank of spare uniform and will ask children who are not following policy to change into appropriate clothing where necessary.

Fidget-toys

Only children who have been assessed as requiring the use of a fidget toy to aid regulation may use them. These will be provided by school to ensure that the correct provision is in place to meet their individual needs and that the products are inline with health and safety requirements. Children must not bring their own fidgets from home.
