Year 1

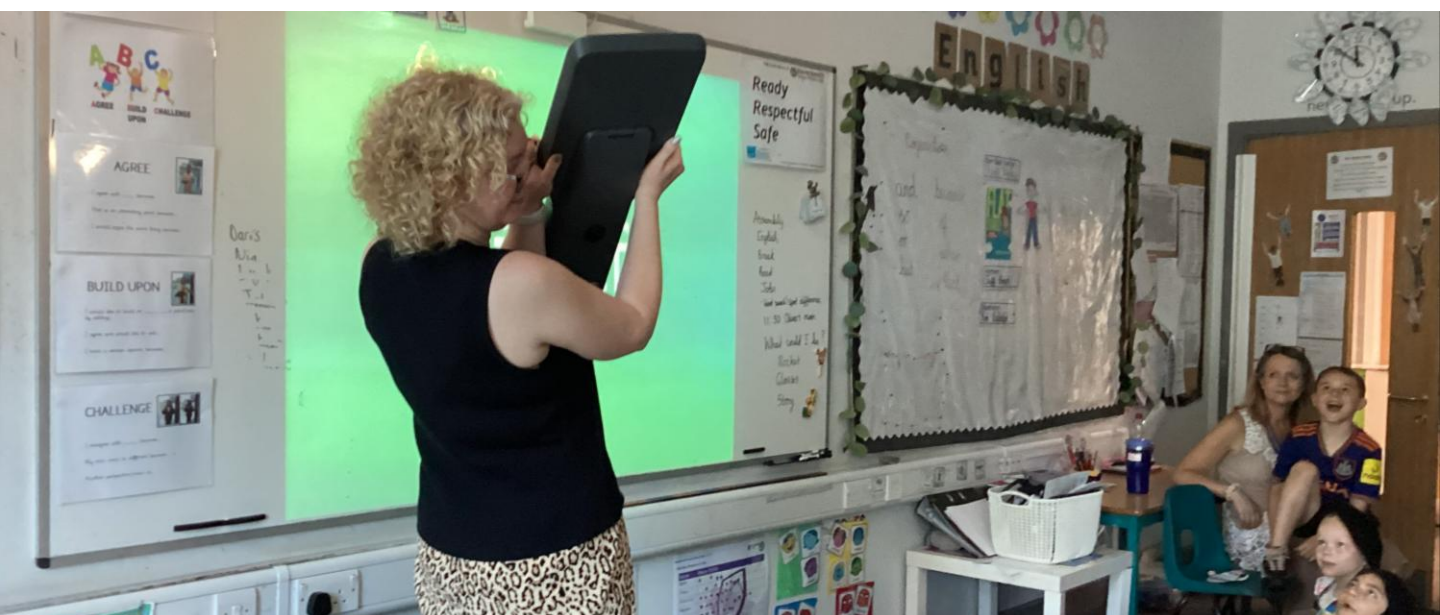
What a fabulous day we had at Sport's Day this week. We enjoyed all of the different stations, especially the very windy egg and spoon race! We hope you enjoyed watching us.

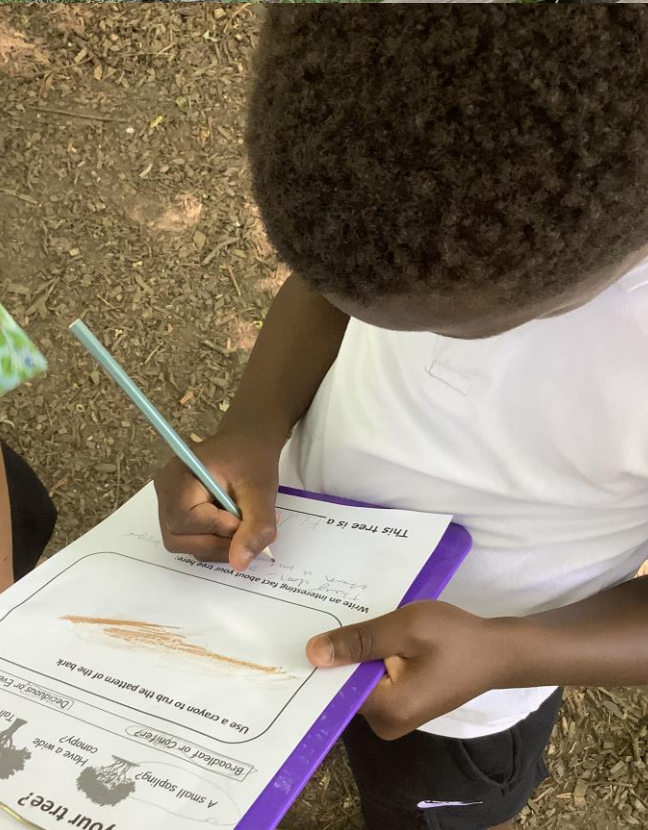
Year 3 News

Year 4

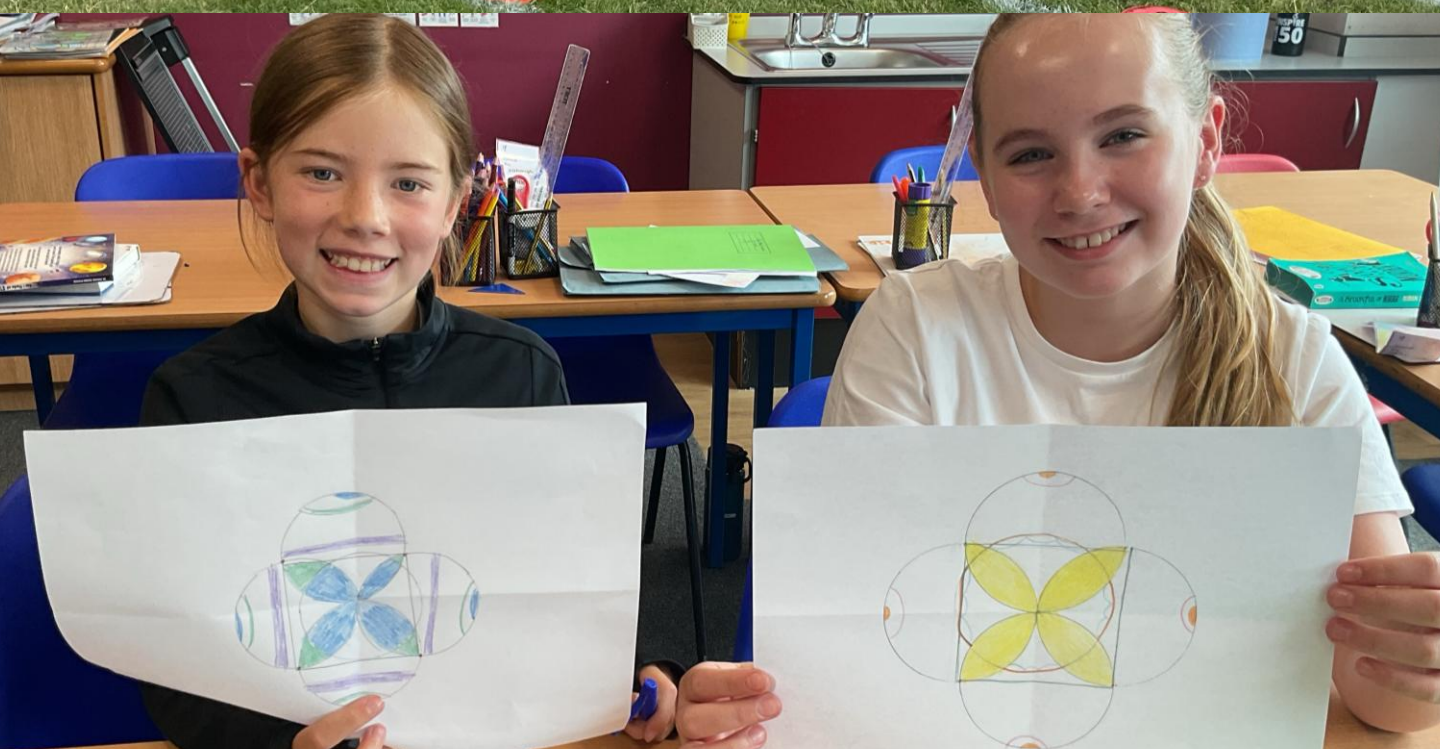

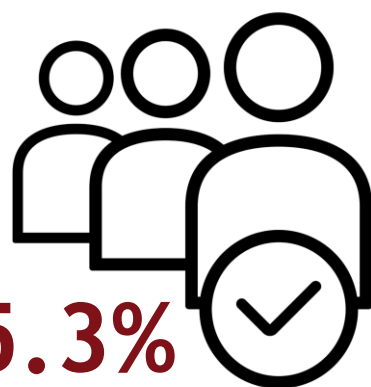


Year 6

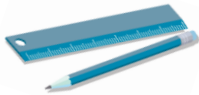

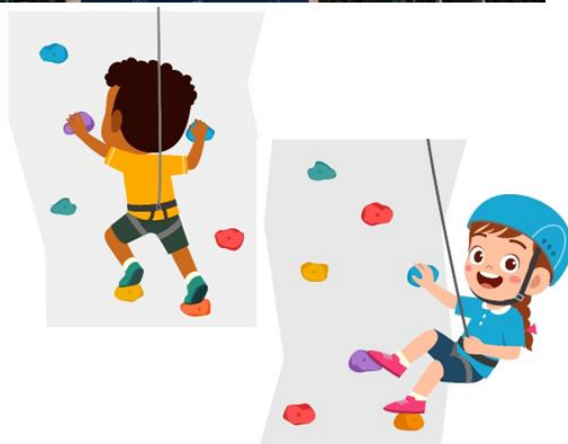
