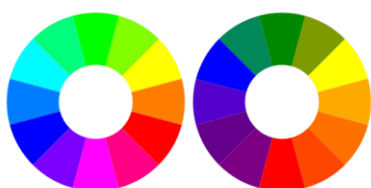
This is important as it:

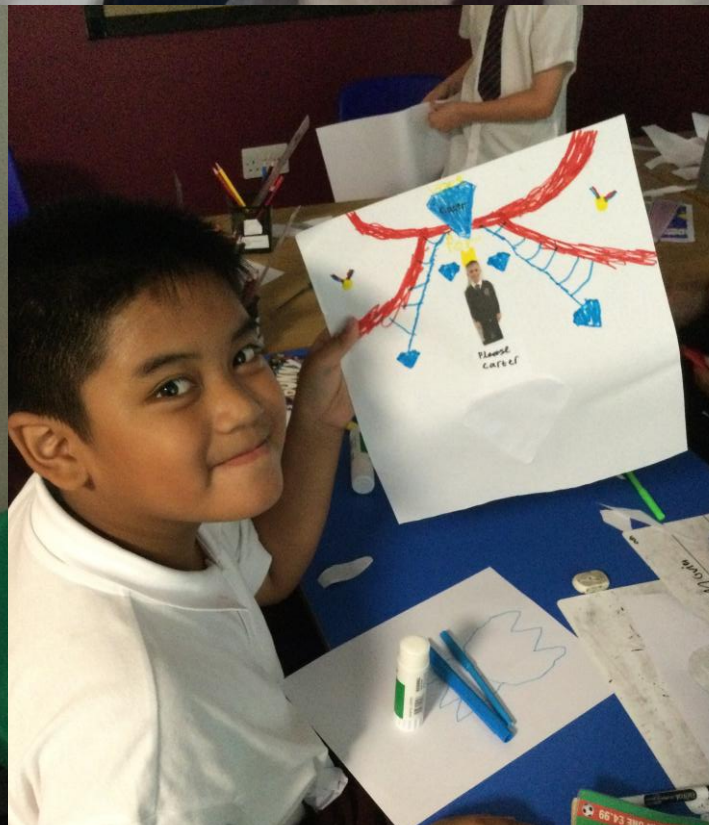

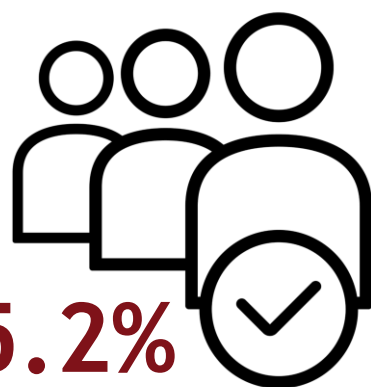
