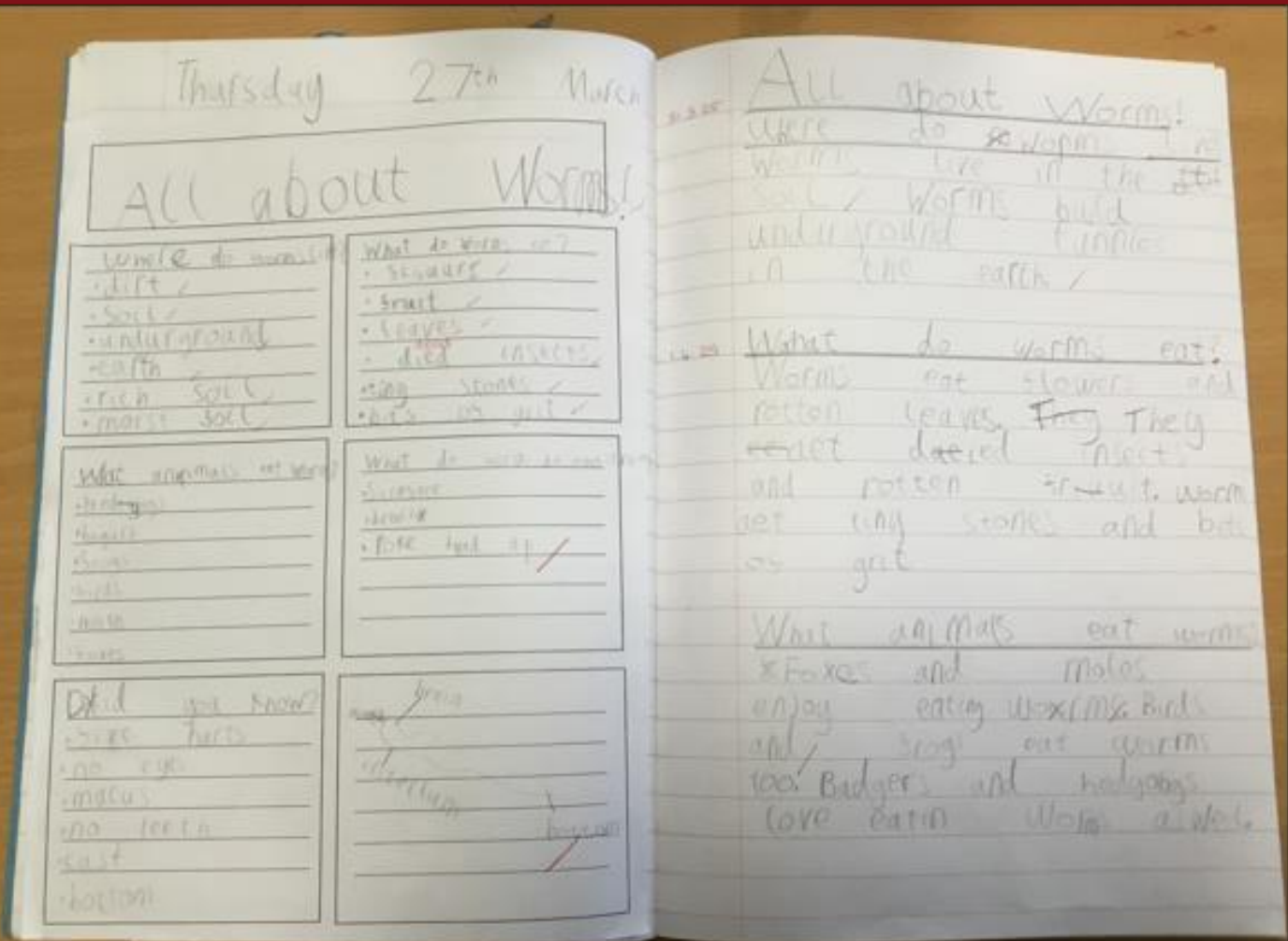
Meet the staff

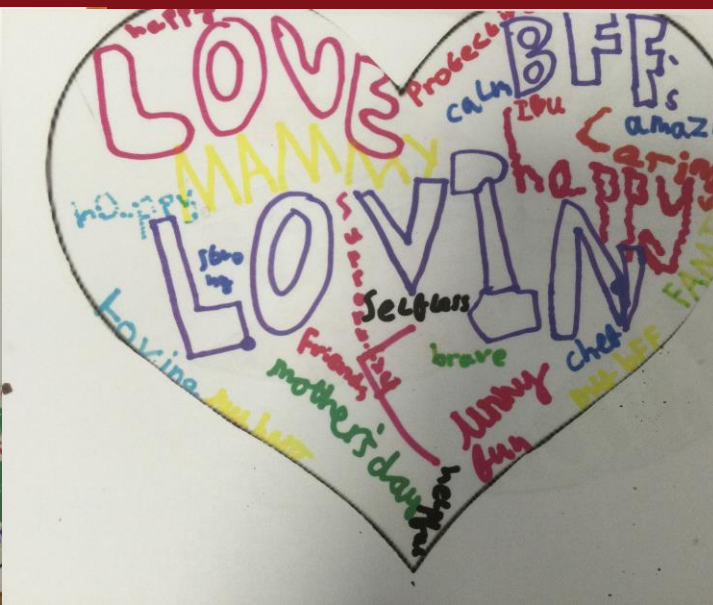
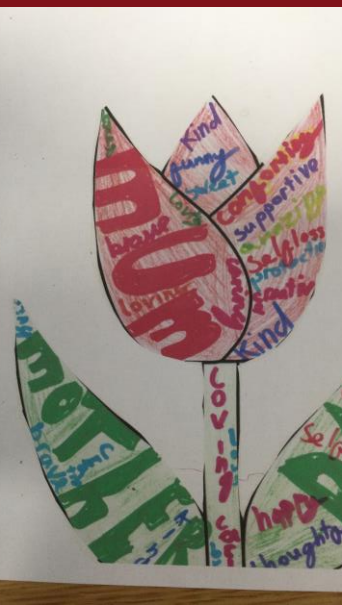
Year 2

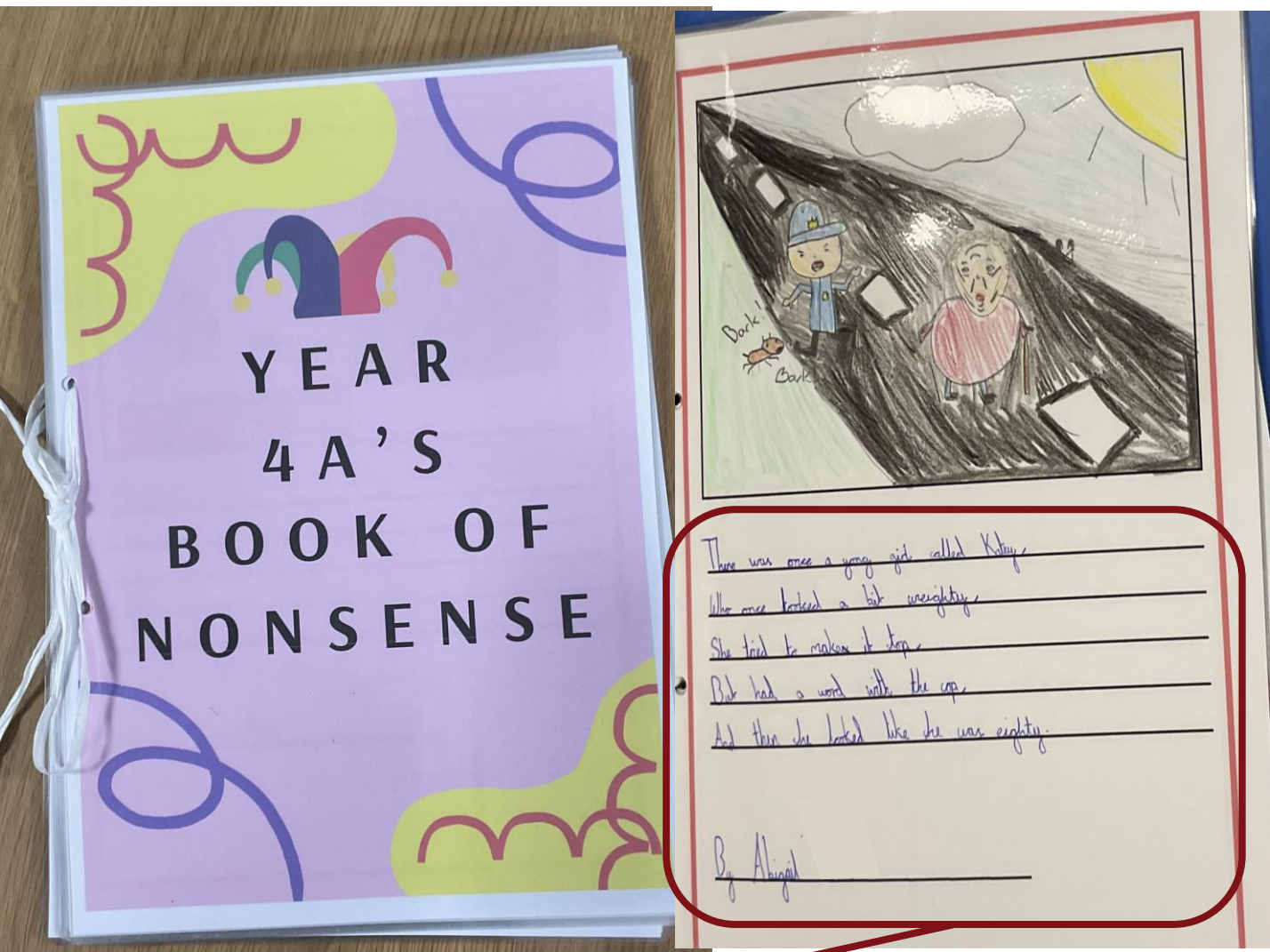

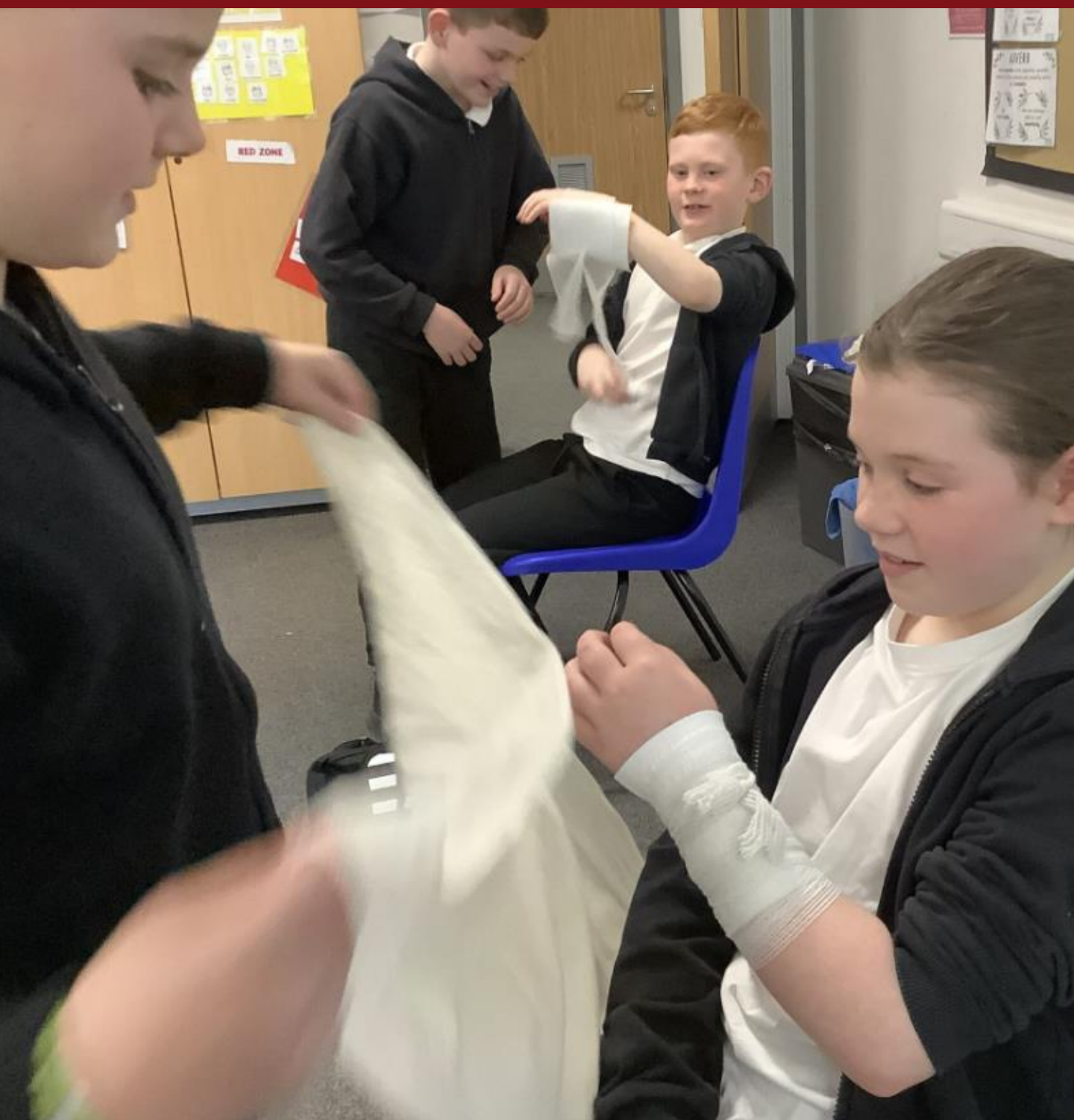

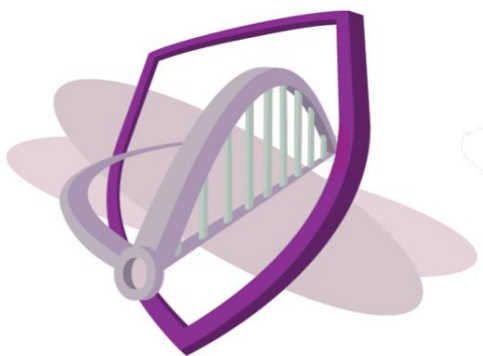


Year 6

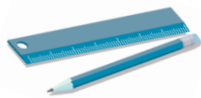

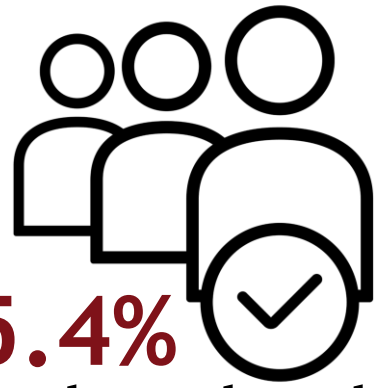
