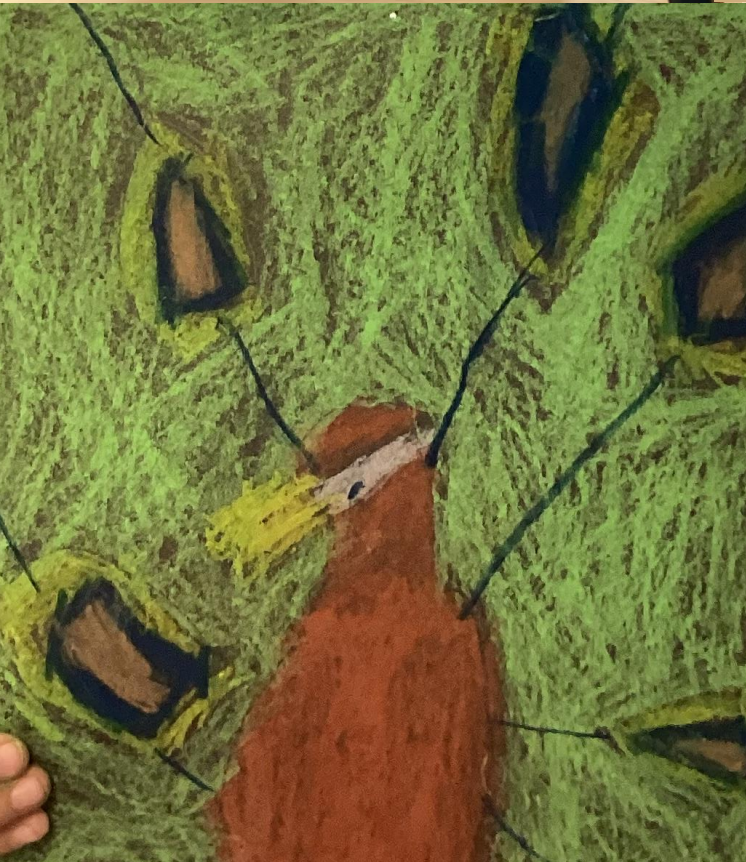

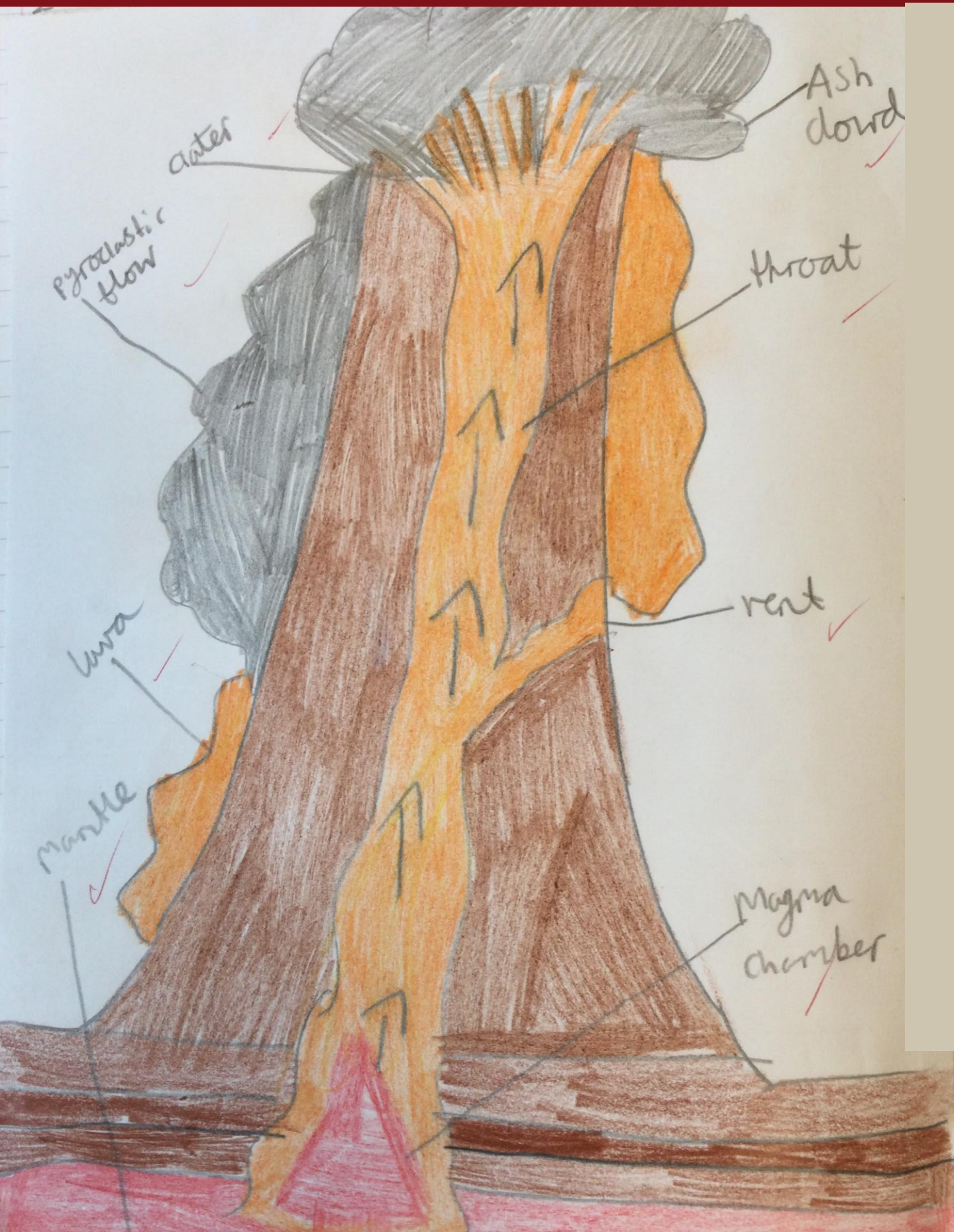
# Year 2

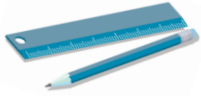

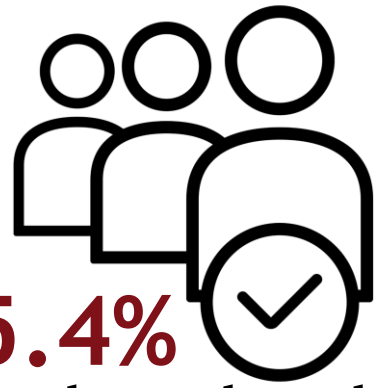
