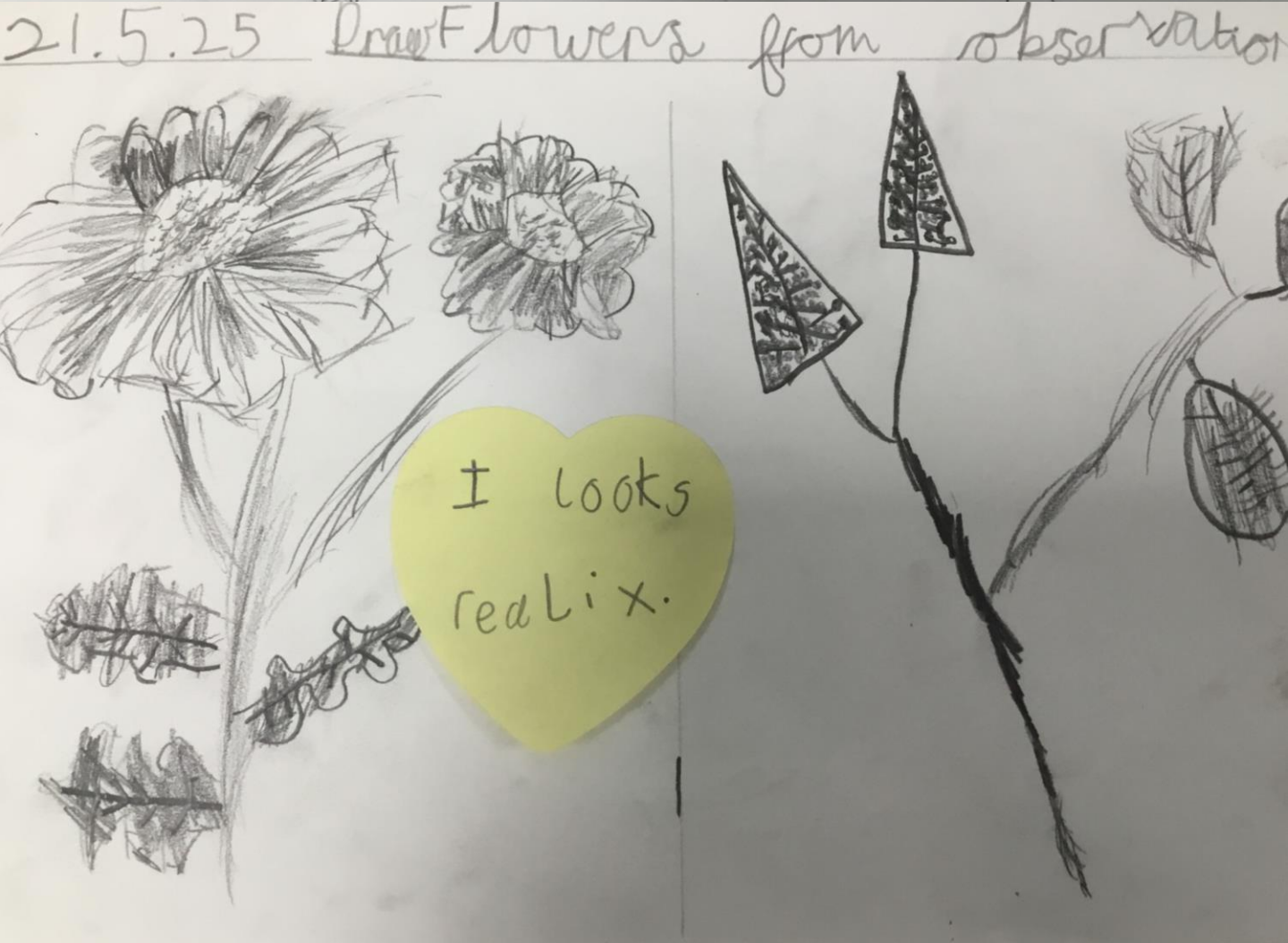
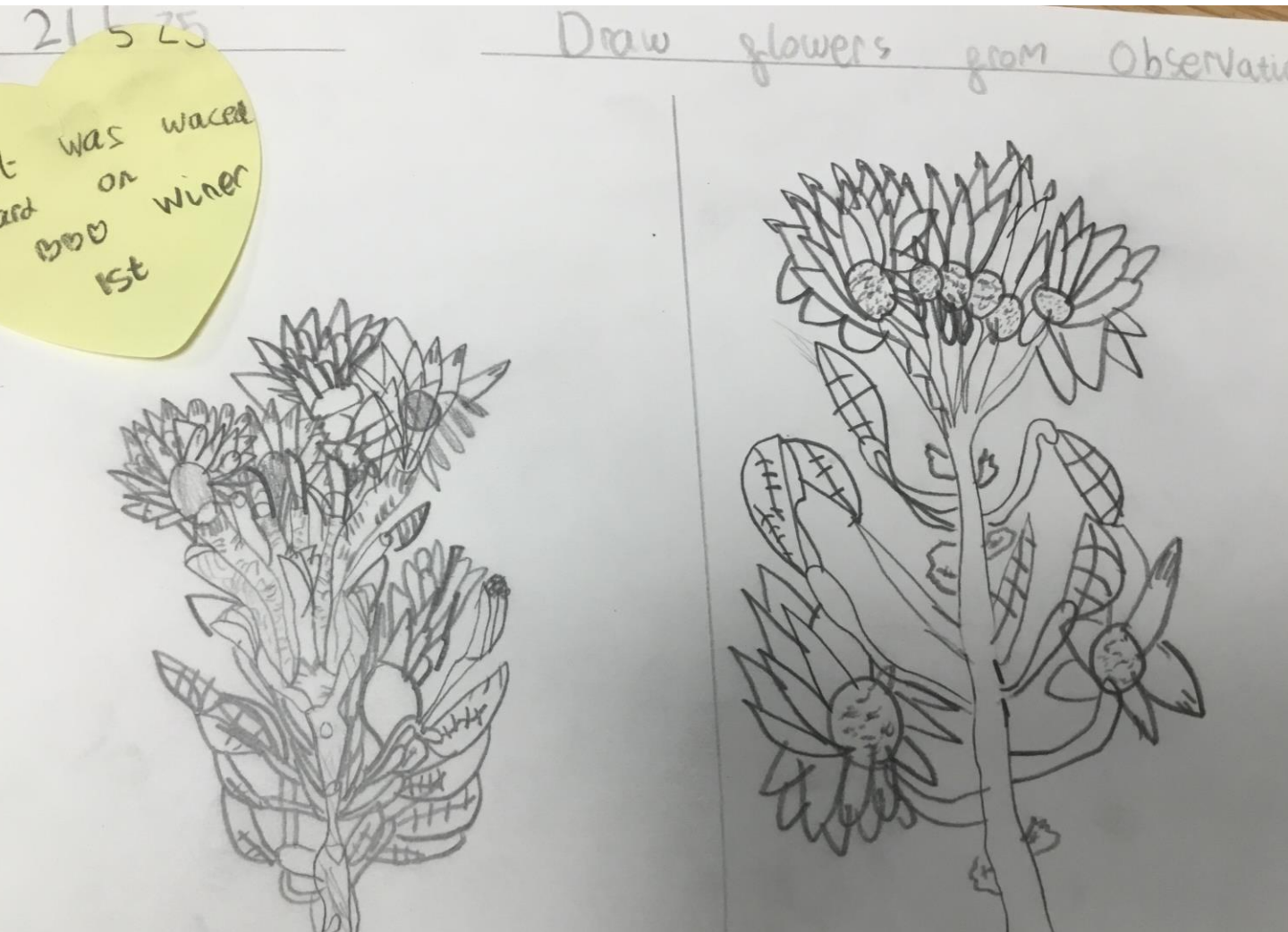
# Year 1

# Year 2

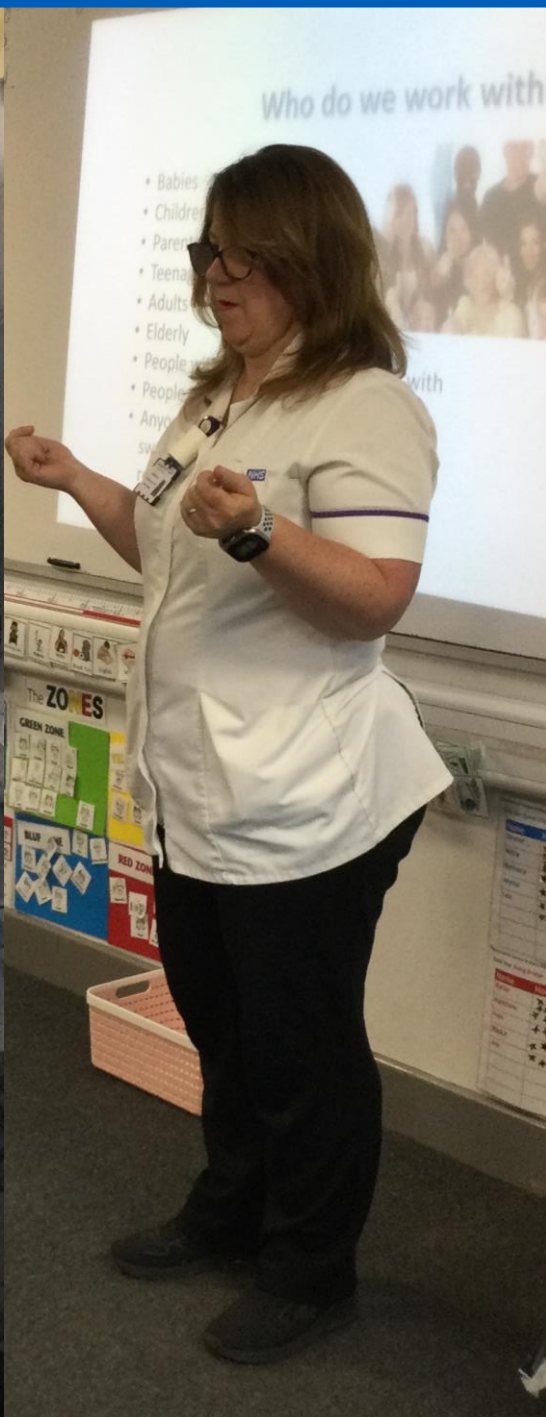
This week we started our new art unit 'Flower Heads'. Look at our fabulous observational drawings!

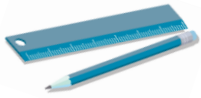

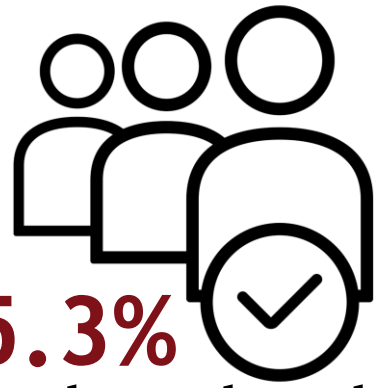

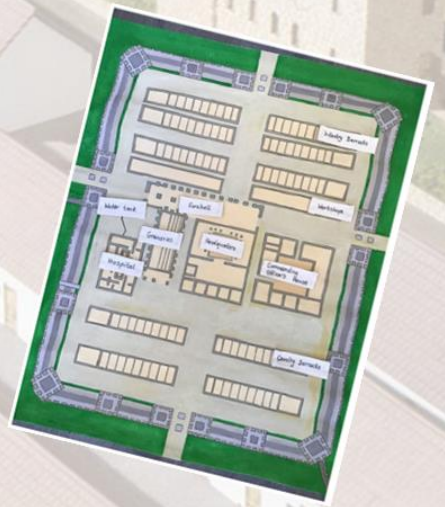
