2. Chop the fruit into small chunks.



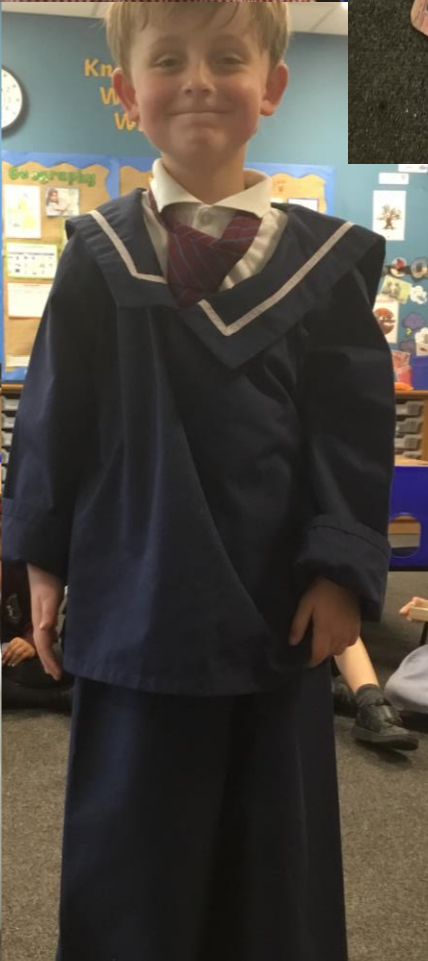
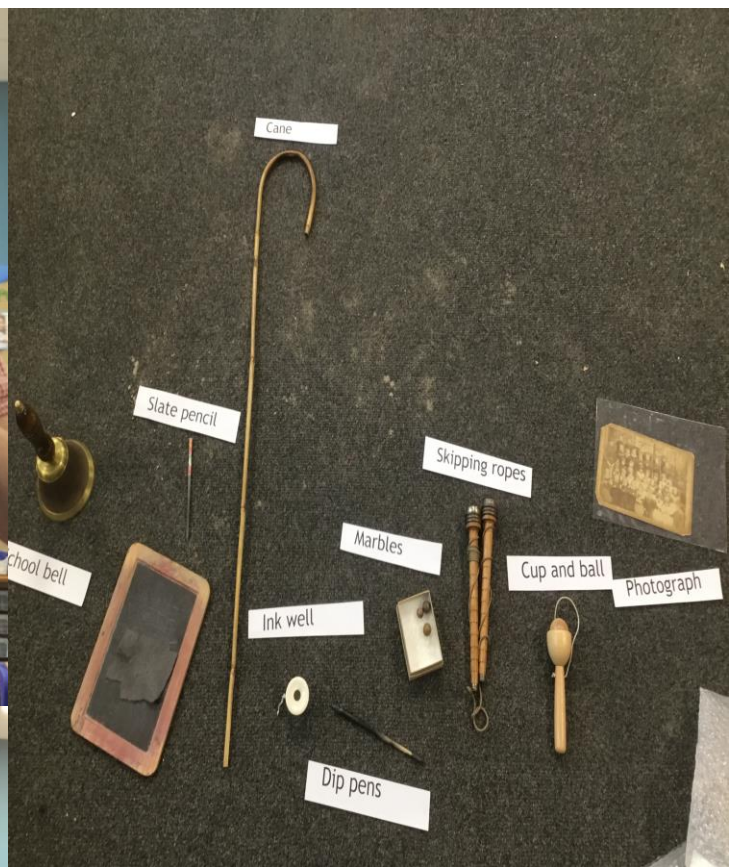
3. Push the fruit onto the skewer.

It is important that we maintain high expectations and high standards which apply to all aspects of school life including our 3 school rules.

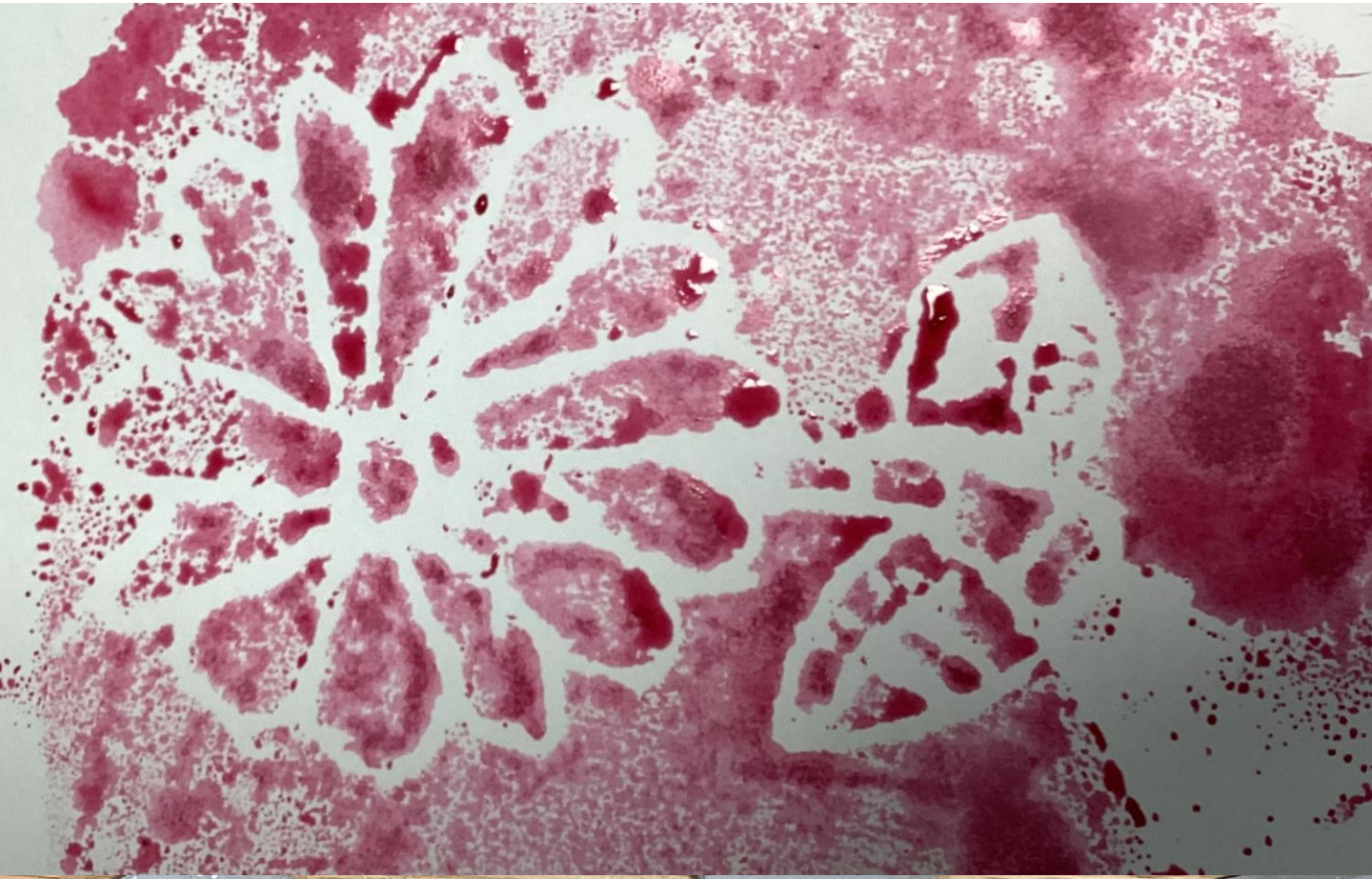
Ready | **Respectful** | **Safe**

This week we have been very creative in our Art lessons. We have created our own clay imprints of flowers and have made our own printing blocks.



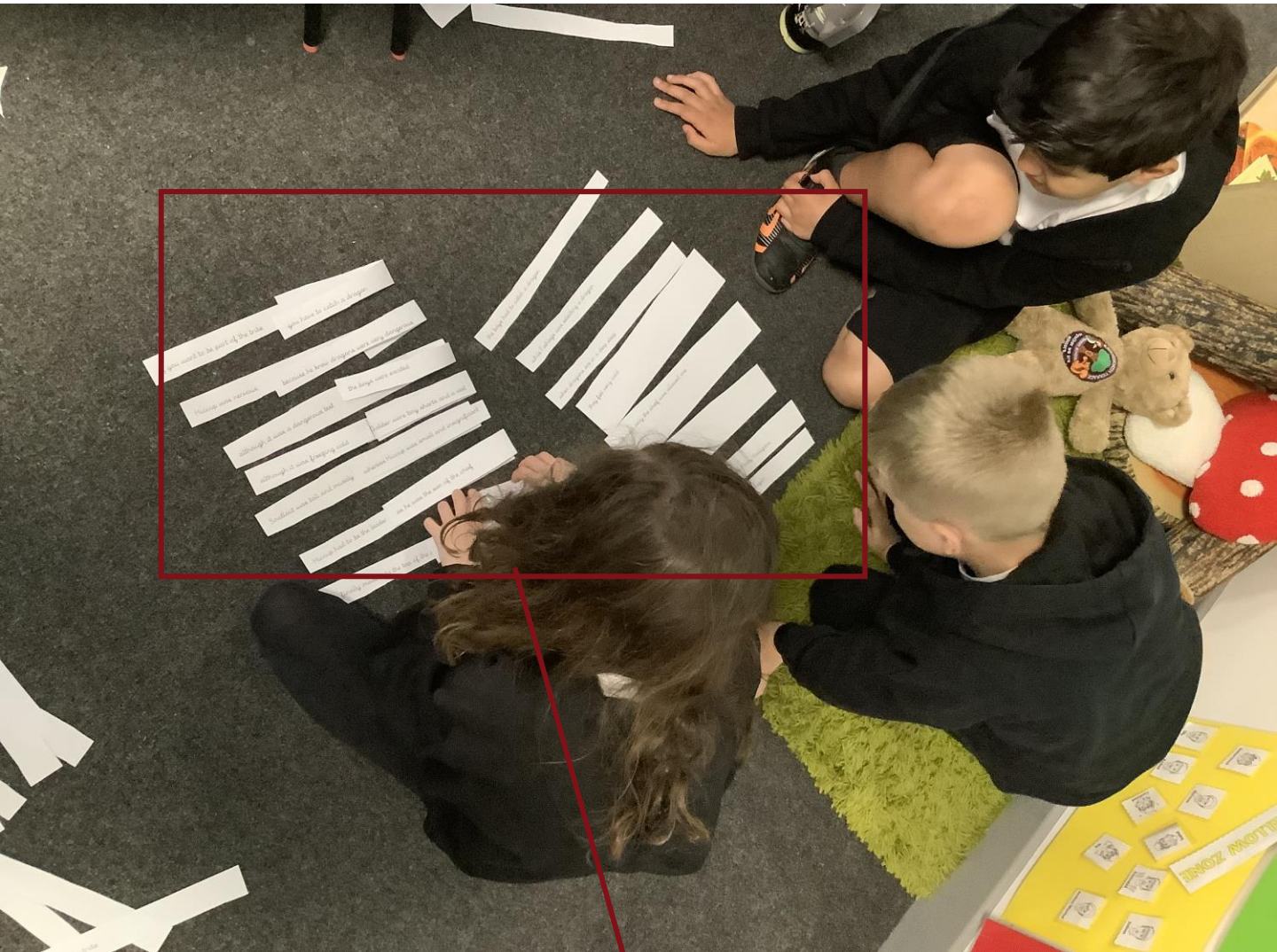
Year 3
