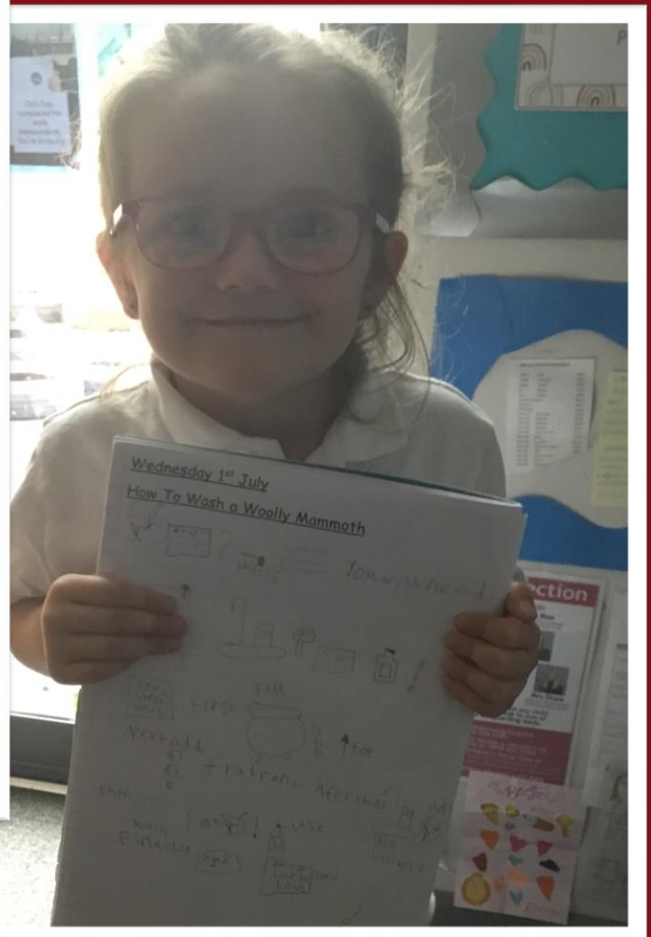
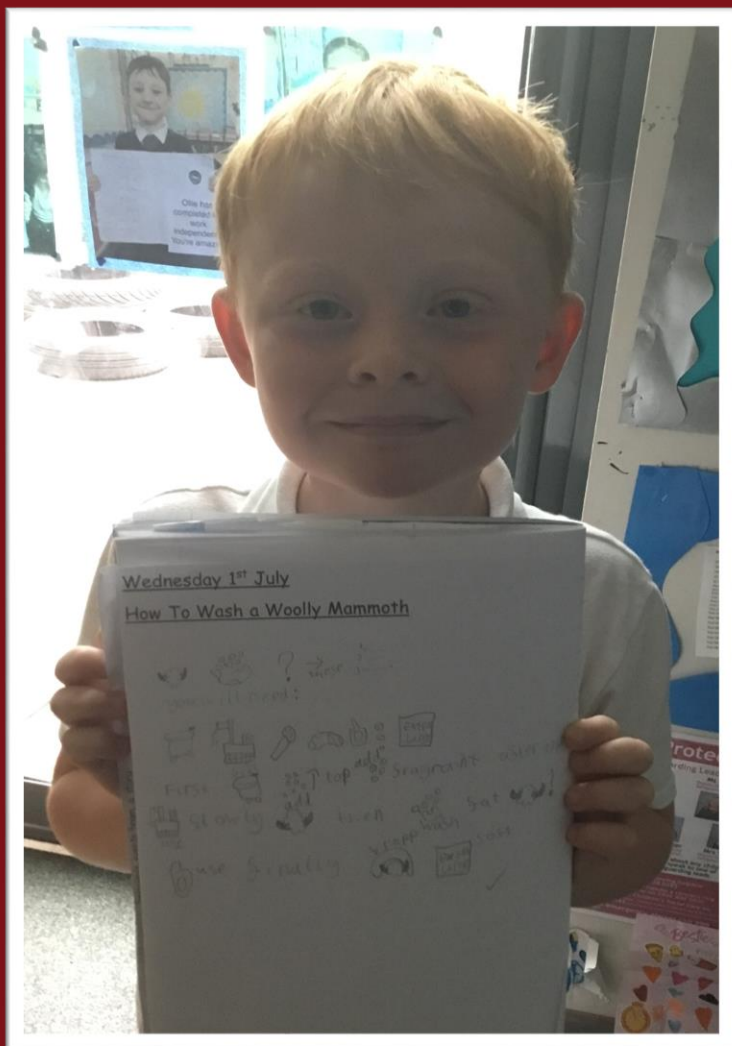
Reception

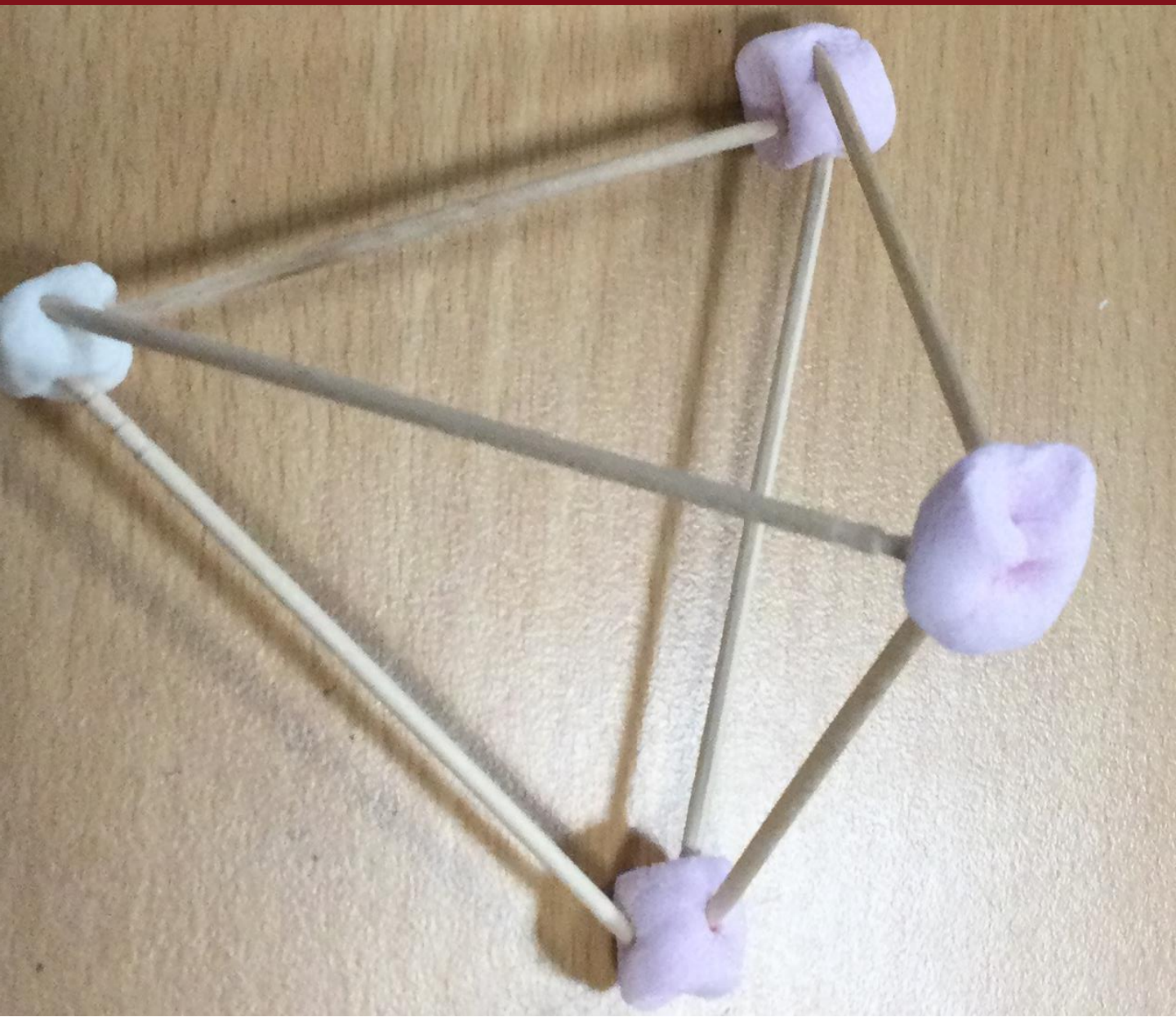
Year 2

9. DO NOT cause harm to your dragon. This will upset it, scare it and you could even make it feel angry.



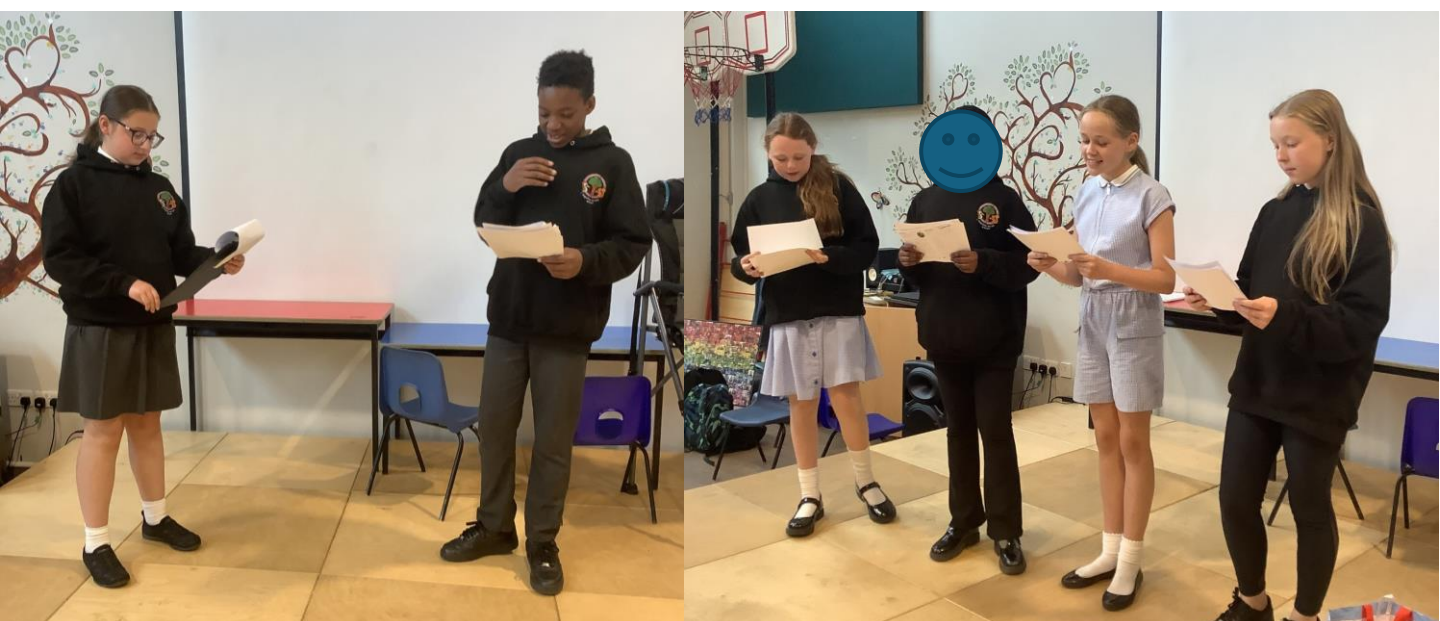
Year 5

Last week, Year 5 went to Lord Lawson to play rounders, cricket and tennis. They all had lots of fun, and we were really impressed with the teamwork!

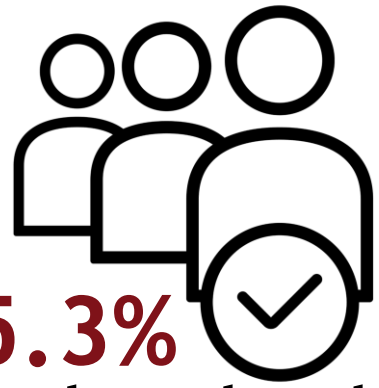


Year 6
