The children practised crossing the road safely with their peers, looking right, left and right again!



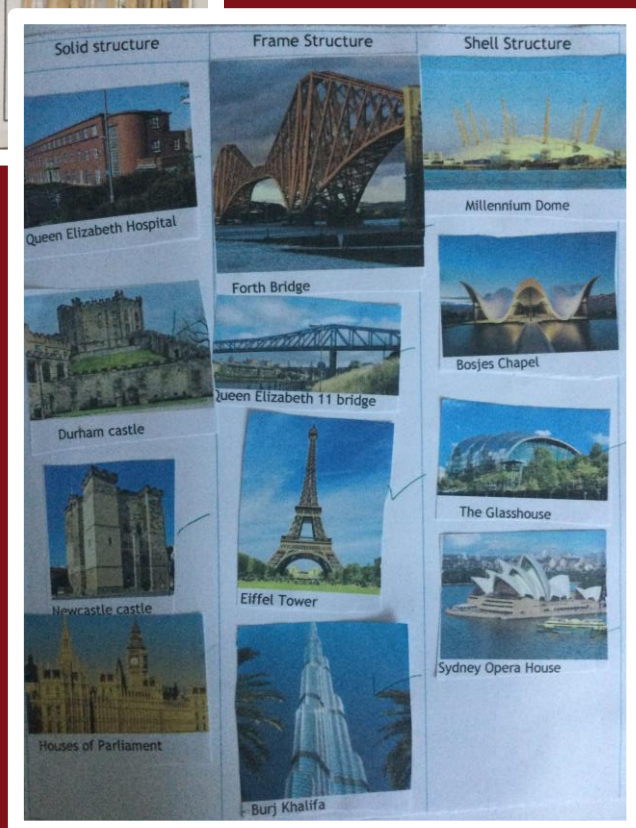
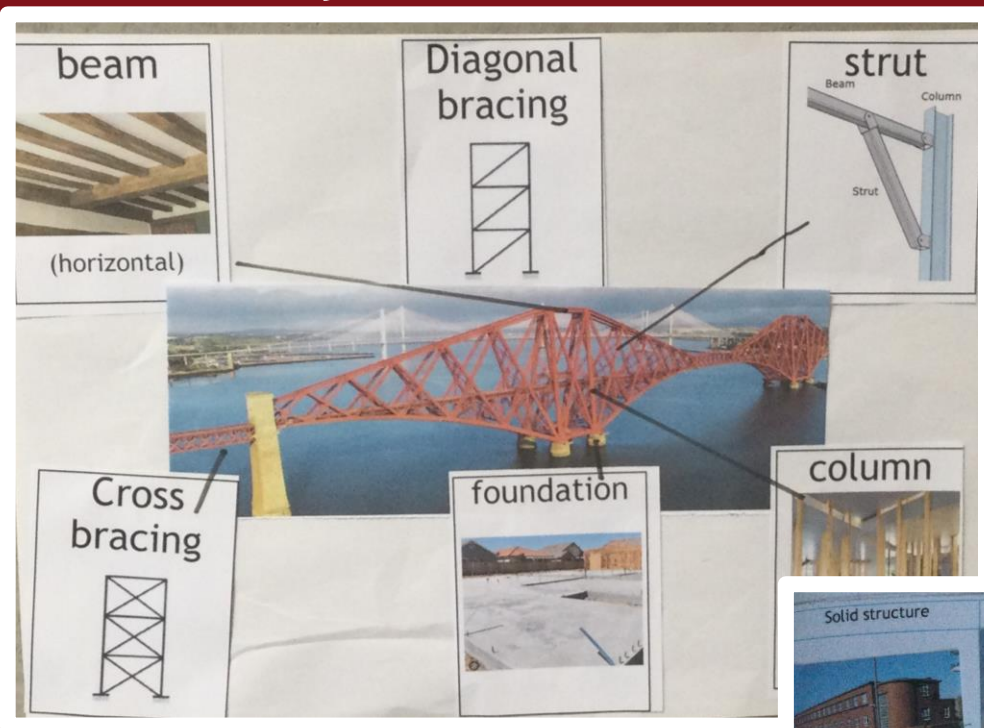
Year 2

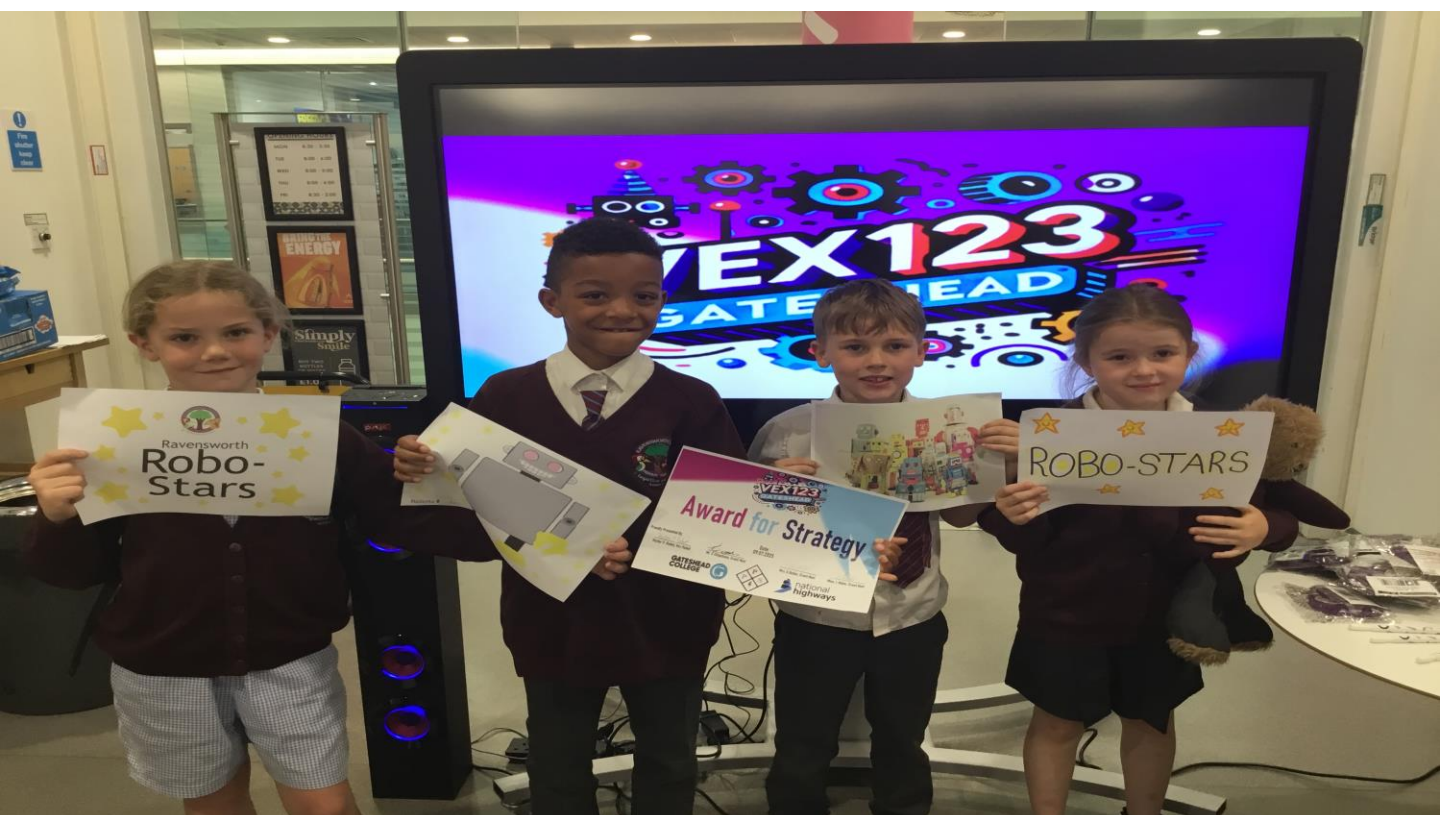
Year 6

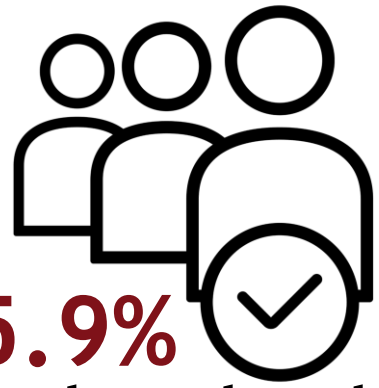


Robotics Team
